## **Special Issue Aims and Scope:**

The **Turkish Journal of Biology**, published by the Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey (TÜBİTAK), is an international resource for the latest information on the most crucial areas of research and reports in life sciences in general. Indexed in Thomson Reuters ISI/SCIE Web of Science and many others, the **Turkish Journal of Biology** would like to announce that it is now accepting expert reviews or original research paper submissions for publication in a special issue on "**Regenerative and Restorative Biology**", planned for late 2015. The editors of the issue will be Prof Margaret Buckingham, Department of Developmental and Stem Cell Biology, Pasteur Institute (Paris, France), and Assist Prof Dr Fatih Kocabaş, Regenerative Biology Research Laboratory, Department of Genetics and Bioengineering, Yeditepe University (İstanbul, Turkey). Submissions to this special issue will cover, but are not restricted to, the following topics:

- Genetics and epigenetics of regeneration
- Tissue homeostasis and stem cells
- Stem and progenitor cell involvement in regeneration
- Identification and use of regenerative cells in medicine
- Applications of stem cells to regeneration
- New emerging cell therapies
- Organ and organism-specific stem cells
- Tissue engineering and applications in tissue restoration
- Molecular mechanisms of regeneration
- Computational approaches and models of regeneration
- Biophysics of regeneration and tissue restoration
- Biochemical and small molecule approaches to regeneration
- Animal models of tissue regeneration and degeneration

**Submission Period:** 1 January to 15 August 2015

**Publication Date:** Second half of 2015

## **Submission Process:**

All manuscripts must be submitted electronically via the Internet to the **Turkish Journal of Biology** through the online system for TÜBİTAK journals at <http://online.journals.tubitak.gov.tr/login.htm?BIY>. You will be guided stepwise through the creation and uploading of the various files. There are no page charges.

Papers are accepted for publication on the understanding that they have not been published and are not going to be considered for publication elsewhere. Authors should certify that neither the manuscript nor its main contents have already been published or submitted for publication in another journal. The copyright release form, which can be found at <http://journals.tubitak.gov.tr/genel/copyright.pdf>, must be signed by the corresponding author on behalf of all authors and must accompany all papers submitted. Please see the form for additional copyright details.

Manuscripts may be rejected without peer review by the editor-in-chief if they do not comply with the instructions for authors or if they are beyond the scope of the special issue. After a manuscript has been accepted for publication, i.e. after referee-recommended revisions are complete, the author will not be permitted to make changes that constitute departures from the manuscript that was accepted by the editor. Before publication, the galley proofs are always sent to the authors for corrections. Mistakes or omissions that occur due to some negligence on our part during final printing will be rectified in an errata section in a later issue. This does not include those errors left uncorrected by the author in the galley proof. Please see the instructions for authors of the Turkish Journal of Biology for detailed information on submission process and manuscript preparation.
